#### Why is it important to start with the germinal question?

# helps

#### the person start out with a particular memory rather than with generalizations

also helps the person focus on the purpose

What to do if the person freezes up after the germinal question?

## ask

#### the person "what went through their mind just now?"

## mention a topic

#### that the person brought up in the information session

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## why?

It doesn't matter where they begin, because the person will get around to all their topics

It also helps them realize they are leading the session, not you
